**Warranty:** I guarantee this Boxer's health for two weeks, provided that he's examined by a licensed veterinarian within three working days of this agreement and that you follow sound health and feeding practice; incompletely vaccinated puppies should not be allowed to meet neighbours' dogs. **If a problem is found, at your choice, I will pay reasonable vet. fees; replace the puppy (if I'm able); or take back the Boxer, refunding the sale price.**

**Breeding:** I advocate neutering pet Boxers.  
**Ear Crop:** Not essential. May be done after eight weeks. Be sure that immunisations are current.  
**Feed:** I use lams and will give you a starter supply. Good food costs more but pays for itself. Follow package directions; I moisten slightly with hot water. Up to ¼ of a meal may be good hamburger, cooked liver, cottage cheese or canned food (good brand) ; don't get carried away. If you change food, do it slowly mixing new with old. Young puppies need three meals daily. Remove uneaten food, within fifteen minutes.

**Health:** Keep your yard picked up, burying, or flushing the excreta. In this area we must battle fleas, flies & roaches. Keep immunisations current.

**House Training:** Consistency is the answer. Anoint the potty place with soiled paper or use puppy pads. Out he goes after food, play, and awakening. Give lavish praise when he performs. Crates are good as they supply a place of his own .. he shouldn't get free run of the house before his systems are mature. Don't scold him until he knows what's expected. **Never** call him to you for scolding or chastising , you'll confuse him; call him to you for **good** things only. His memory is short, he loves you and wants to please you.

**Parasites: Coccidia.** An amoeba like organism, frequently causes diarrhoea; Albon, from your vet. is the cure.

**Parasites. Fleas & ticks.** Dangerous , carrying tapeworms and diseases. Get a control plan from your vet. When exterminating, be sure to include your attics, garages and vehicles. Flea collars are useless.

**Parasites: Worms.** Have his stool checked if you suspect worms; don't worm unless you know that he has them.

Continue **heartworm** prophylaxis year round.

**Enjoy your Boxer for many years. If you get problems, call me. I'll help.**
